



# SHUTTLE MEADOW COUNTRY CLUB

## DRESS CODE

The Shuttle Meadow Country Club dress code is intended to assist in maintaining a comfortable yet appropriate atmosphere which is one of our hallmarks. Members are responsible for assuring that their children and guests comply with these guidelines. The following chart is provided as a guide to members in determining proper attire:

### Country Club Casual

Men and Boys - Appropriate golf/tennis attire consisting of a collared shirt, turtleneck or mock turtleneck with slacks or hemmed shorts (Bermuda length and above the knee) or tennis shorts and collared tennis/polo shirts. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

Women and Girls - Appropriate golf/tennis attire (must have sleeves or collar or both), golf skirts, hemmed shorts or tennis dresses, skirts, or shorts and a tailored tennis top.

Shoes - For golf: those designed specifically for golf with soft spikes or smooth soles. For tennis: court shoes designed specifically for tennis; sneakers for platform tennis.

Special Club Events - Dress will be publicized.

### Not Permitted - Adults and Children

- Tee Shirts
- Halter tops; tank tops
- Cargo pants or shorts
- Sweat Suits
- Leggings
- Slippers
- Casual sandals such as rubber/plastic flip-flops (except at pool)
- Bathing attire is not allowed outside of the pool enclosure including parking lots and tennis area.
- Bare midriffs
- Hats in the clubhouse after 6:00pm
- Shorts in Dining Room after 6:00pm
- Hats or caps worn backwards-rally style
- Metal spiked shoes
- Casual attire in the lounge or patio during special dining events
- Street shoes or footwear with traction cleats are not allowed for platform tennis.
- At the pool: Bermuda shorts, cut-off jeans, or any other substitute for bathing suits are not allowed in the pool

### **Denim & Jean Policy**

Denim/dress jeans may be worn in the Grille Room, the Bar/Lounge and the patio only. Denim is not allowed in the Dining Room, Ballroom, North Porch or the Ninth Green Dining Room at any time. Also, it is not allowed on the tennis courts, paddle tennis courts, golf course or practice facility.

Denim/dress jeans must be clean, in good repair and tasteful in appearance. Clothing shall not be ripped, frayed, patched or otherwise damaged. The clothing must be worn as designed and fit its wearer. Shirts must be tucked in at all times in the clubhouse.

Members are responsible to identify the denim/jeans policy of SMCC to their guests.

Compliance with the dress code will help to create a pleasant atmosphere for all. Non-compliance will require an initiation of action as determined by the Board of Directors.
